

Lori Nugent to speak on cyber risk at NY conference

Lori S. Nugent (Partner-Chicago) will speak at the American Conference Institute's 4th Annual Cyber & Data Risk Insurance Conference to be held September 27-28, 2010, at the Helmsley Park Lane Hotel in New York City. The event will address leading practices in cyber and data risk management.

Lori, Co-Chair of the firm's Data Security and Privacy Practice and its Technology Practice, will present on "Key Considerations to Limit Liability When Dealing with Third-Party Vendors & Suppliers."
